

LAND WEST OF SIBFORD ROAD, HOOK NORTON

PUBLIC CONSULTATION : 6TH DECEMBER – 20TH DECEMBER 2024

Notification of Public Consultation for a housing scheme of up to 55 dwellings with associated infrastructure open space and provision of affordable housing.

The Site and Planning Context

The site comprises 2.45ha of land, largely comprising an agricultural field to the west of Sibford Road.

The Site has a Public Right of Way (PRoW), which runs diagonally on a north-west to south-east axis, connecting to Bourne Lane to the south-east and leading

into the open fields beyond to the north-west. This will be retained and enhanced as part of the proposals.

The Site is located in a sustainable location close to local facilities and services in Hook Norton, which are easily accessible by walking and cycling including being less than 200m walking distance from Hook Norton Primary School.
